

### **What I Need to Know**

- QRFS promotes fire prevention and fire management. Part of the QRFS role is raising community awareness by alerting members of the public to the need for them to protect themselves and their properties from bushfire.
- A wide range of resource materials on fire prevention, mitigation, and suppression and other promotional material is freely available for distribution by brigades to property owners and other interested community members.
- Stocks of brochures and community awareness resources are available from the local Area Office. Some Area Offices do not have storage facilities to accommodate large stocks and may refer the order to Central Office.
- There is no charge to brigades for community awareness material.

### **How I do it**

- Submit orders for community awareness material to the Area Office.
- Allow at least 10 days for supply to be arranged. (Urgent or “last minute” requests cannot be guaranteed.)
