

What I Need to Know

- The QRFS participates from time to time in special promotions, displays and presentations. Participation is via Area Office and individual brigades. Brigades are encouraged to undertake their own activities with advice from their Area Office.
- Resources available for displays and promotions include:
 - RFS marquees and display units from some Area Offices
 - A range of promotional items through the Area Office
 - Community awareness brochures through the ordering procedure.
- Some events that brigades/Area Offices may wish to promote throughout the year are:
 - Area shows
 - FireEd School Program
 - Promotion of installation of smoke alarms in rural and remote townships
 - Regional firefighter championships
 - Fire Awareness Week
 - Duracell “Change your smoke alarm battery” campaign.
- While a number of these events have fixed dates, the timing and location of some are at the discretion of individual brigades, Area Offices and Central Office.

How I do it

- Contact your Area Office for details of local events.
- Make marquee and display unit bookings through your Area Office well in advance of the event.
- To order brochures/promotional material, submit a brigade requisition form through your Area Office.
