

What I Need to Know

The Commissioner has granted approval for officers of brigades to wear the QFRS station wear. The Commissioner's approval is conditional on the uniform being worn in a complete and unaltered manner. To wear the uniform in other than a complete and unaltered manner denigrates the uniform, the wearer, the brigade, the volunteer movement and QFRS.

QFRS station wear must not be worn by persons other than those for whom it was purchased.

Upon ceasing brigade membership, a person in possession of the QFRS station wear must remove any badges or other accoutrements that may give the impression that the wearer is a member of the QFRS or a brigade.

How I do it

- Order uniform items by utilising the standard Rural Brigade Requisition Form.
- Write the correct uniform sizes on the requisition as these items are not returnable. (Uniform items are classed as special items and are not part of the subsidised equipment list.)
- Access the latest copy of the "Equipment Catalogue" and "Price List" on the volunteer portal for a list of available items.
- The Brigade Secretary signs the completed order and forwards it to the Rural Operations Area Office for approval and processing.
