

What I Need to Know

- The GIS/Risk Management unit provides a wide range of mapping products to Rural Fire Brigades. These include:
 - Rural Brigade Maps - maps of brigade areas that can be used for operational firefighting (Updated maps are supplied when boundary amendments are made.)
 - Bushfire Risk Maps - maps identifying areas of high, medium or low bushfire risk - based on inputs of slope, vegetation and aspect - often used by councils for planning scheme preparation to regulate development
 - South East Queensland 1:25000 Atlas Series
 - iZone Maps - maps identifying the interface zone – where flammable vegetation abuts residential areas
 - Rural Group Maps – maps showing brigades within a specific Rural Group.
