It is the primary means of imparting important information to volunteers. A copy is mailed to each brigade secretary, first officer and fire warden as well as to brigade group administration officers and local authorities.

As well as articles of interest to both brigade members and fire wardens, the *Bulletin* provides information on awards, research, equipment updates and community events. Contributions from brigade members and fire wardens are invited.
