

What I Need to Know

- Rural Fire Brigades already operate within a written constitution and are able to conduct social activities under existing structures and procedures. It is therefore not considered appropriate for brigades to become incorporated under the Association Incorporations Act 1981. Neither is it appropriate for Rural Fire Brigades or their members to utilise their association with the Rural Fire Service to raise funds to spend on social activities.
- QFRS Standing Order (SO) SO-Q-BM-2.3 – QFRS Social Clubs does not apply to Rural Fire Brigades
