

What I Need to Know

- RFS will supply brigades with communications equipment subject to need and the discretion of the Area Director, Rural Operations.
- A base station unit comprises the radio, power supply, antenna and connection cable. The hand-held unit comprises the radio, battery, battery charger and leather holster.
- QRFS can supply ancillary equipment such as microphones and extension speakers only at the time of purchase of the radio.
- Equipment supplied is VHF or UHF commercial. CB equipment will not be supplied.

How I do it

- Access information on available items in the Equipment Catalogue. These are sent to the brigade secretaries each year. The latest version of each document is available on the Volunteer Portal.
- Contact your Area Director Rural Operations with your requirements.
